

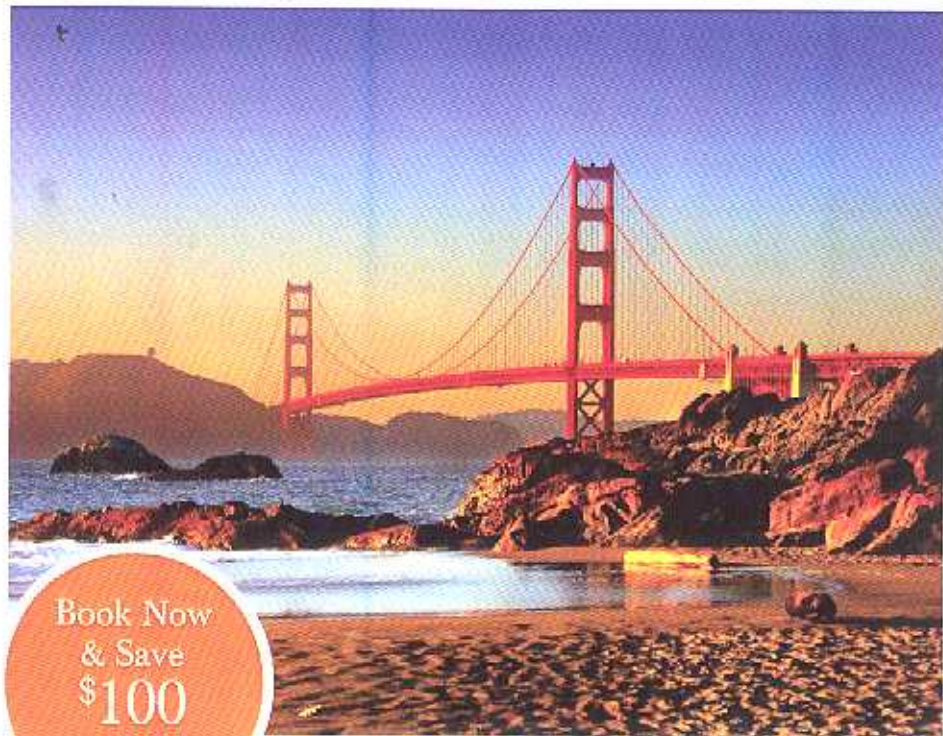

Air passengers will depart from San Francisco airport. All transfers will depart from Novato for San Francisco airport.

Economy air rate and schedule are applicable for groups of 10 or more traveling on the same flights and dates.

A deposit of \$500 per person is due upon reservation. If you purchase our Travel Protection Plan, the deposit is only \$250 per person plus the cost of the insurance. Reservations are made on a first come, first served basis. Reservations made after the deposit due date of January 22, 2018 are based upon availability. Final payment due by May 30, 2018. Deposits are refundable up until January 29, 2018.
